- Improve & maintain communication
  - Comprehensive and accessible telecommunications network
  - Connected citizens
  - Inclusivity
- Ensure best possible location of masts
  - Least visual impact
  - Consider all possible alternatives
  - Use existing structures where possible
  - Co-location or sharing wherever possible
  - Retain visual integrity & character of local surroundings
  - Integrate with surrounding landscape - mitigate visual impact
- Preserve areas of environmental or heritage significance
- No interference with any other utility functions
- Protect the health, safety and wellbeing of inhabitants
  - Restricted access to masts
  - Enforce compliance with ICNIRP exposure guidelines
  - Safety zone enforcement (50m *at antenna level*)
