

GRANT-IN-AID 2017/18

REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING

Arts and culture

The City of Cape Town's Arts and Culture Branch invites applications for funding from arts, culture and heritage organisations and institutions located within its municipal boundaries.

Proposals should focus on providing creative and innovative programmes and/or services that address challenges faced by vulnerable youth and youth currently involved in arts and culture pursuits.

Proposals should look to:

1. develop young people to be positive role models
2. provide young people with positive activities and transferable skills
3. improve self-worth by igniting a passion for culture and heritage
4. introduce youth to artistic and cultural activities and to professional artists
5. help build communities by fostering an appreciation for the arts
6. help build cultural audiences by exposing youth to the arts

All applicants must have a proven track record of no less than two years. Applicants must be realistic when drafting their proposals as funding is limited and the City will not fund entire proposals. Funding will be distributed equally between the four geographical City areas, and applicants can expect to receive funding in late 2017 for project completion by 31 May 2018. Not all applicants will receive funding.

When preparing their budget, organisations should take note of the Grants-in-Aid Policy, which is available on application and on the City's website: www.capetown.gov.za (search for Grants-in-Aid Policy 2017/18).

Applicants should be registered as a non-profit organisation (i.e. NPO, NGO, section 21, trust, etc.). Supporting documents must be certified and include proof of bank details, NPO certificate, tax clearance certificate, latest municipal services account and latest audited financial statements. Applications will not be accepted unless all supporting documents are included.

Applicants must complete the prescribed application form, which is available at the Arts and Culture office on the 14th Floor, Telkom Tower, Standard Bank Centre, 2 Hertzog Boulevard, Cape Town, or at subcouncil offices. Only original forms will be accepted (no photocopies, faxes or e-mails) and no late submissions will be considered.

The completed application forms should be hand-delivered to the Arts and Culture office by no later than 16:00 on Monday 21 August 2017.
