**'Demystifying Groundwater' - a talk by Dr Ricky Murray**

World renowned hydrologist, terrific raconteur and Kommetjie resident Dr Ricky Murray will be giving a public talk on the subject of groundwater. It will include topics like how groundwater flows in the subsurface, siting boreholes, how sustainable yields are determined, groundwater quality and what you should know if you have a borehole or well in your yard. Dr Murray may also touch on the mayor's latest plans for water supplies for the South Peninsula.

Dr Murray has been involved in groundwater resource assessments since 1984. He's currently working on both large scale bulk-supply projects like Port Elizabeth and Windhoek, town supplies like Plettenberg Bay and Kurland, and regional groundwater resource assessments like Kenya and Ethiopia/South Sudan. He successfully helped Windhoek avert a severe water crisis in the summer of 2016/17 by assisting in developing emergency deep groundwater supplies.
